## Multiflora Rose

Multistemmed shrub with thorny arching vines.

Small serrated leaves with white flowers blooming in late June.

## Japanese Knotweed

Round, red-tinted bamboo style stems reaching 1-3 meters in height Broad oval leaves with pointed end.

**Origin: East Asia** 

## Himalayan Balsam

Hollow, red-tinted stems with tapered saw toothed leaves.

Pink orchid-like flowers blooming in late July/August.

Origin: Western Himalayas
